



Policies and Restrictions

POLICIES

The Pool Club at SCC is a family retreat with a fun, relaxing and safe environment for members and guests.

Our policies and rules are designed to maintain the same goal.

- Members and guests must check in prior to entering the club.
- Members are NOT allowed to bring in any personal alcohol – violations will result in forfeiture of Membership status
- A cleansing shower must be taken prior to entering any pools.
- Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian (who are members) or authorized babysitter/nanny added to the membership.
- Members are welcome to bring their own food and non-alcoholic drinks in unbreakable containers to be consumed in designated areas only.
- Outside vendor catering is not permitted, and food is to be consumed in designated areas only (under covered seating and tables surrounding the Tiki Bar).
- Members may bring the same guest up to 5 times per month and on weekends must provide us 24 hours notice to ensure that scheduled activities are not overcrowded. Members must accompany guests.
- Management and lifeguards are in charge of the club and facilities and are responsible for maintaining our environment. We reserve the right to revise our rules, regulations and hours of operation at any time.

POOL RESTRICTIONS

No air inflated tubes, jackets, masks, toys, flippers webbed feet, or other paraphernalia shall be allowed in the pool except with special permission from management. Non-swimming toddlers will be allowed to utilize a Coastguard approved flotation device when accompanied by an adult.

Rules and Restrictions

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Only toys provided by the club are allowed in the Pools. Please leave your toys at home, certain toys will clog the pool filters.

ADULT POOL

- Available to adults 21 and over. Beverages cannot be brought in the adult pool

LAP POOL

- Appropriate equipment for lap lane swimming used in the lap lanes only. Swimming goggles may be used but face masks that over the nose are prohibited.
- “Bubbles” are NOT considered an appropriate flotation device as defined by the United States Coast Guard. Toddlers are allowed to use Puddle Jumpers that meet USCG requirements but all non-swimming children need to be accompanied by an adult.
- Playing in the lap lanes or on the lap lane lines is not permitted at any time.
- Only one person is allowed at a time on the slides. Quickly swim out of the area beneath the slide upon surfacing. All children using the slide must pass a swim test prior to use – Lifeguards will be in charge of administering the test

SPORTS POOL

- Available to all if no activities have been previously scheduled, please refer to activities board.

CHILDREN’S SPLASH PAD

- Available to all.
- Children under the age of 5 must be accompanied by an adult or guardian member who must be within the splash pad area at all times.

INFANTS AND TODDLERS

All small children must be potty trained to enter either the sports/activities pool. Non potty trained infants and toddlers must wear rubber diapers or “swimmies” to enjoy the *Lap Pool* or *Splash Pad* with accompanying adult.

PARENTAL SUPERVISION

- Lifeguards are not babysitters.
- Parents or guardians are responsible for their children at all times.
- Parents of non-swimmers MUST accompany children in the water. Non-swimmers are children who cannot swim at least 15 yards of the pools unassisted or who require a swim aid of any kind.
- Children under age of 14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who is a member when on the premises.

RULED AND REGULATIONS

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RULES

- No smoking is allowed inside the Pool Club.
- Diaper changing is limited to the changing tables in the rest rooms or on a personal blanket. Please no diaper changing on tables, lounge chairs or eating areas. Please dispose of dirty diapers in plastic bags.
- Admission to the pools and club may be refused to anyone with head colds, coughs, inflamed eyes or infections and/or anyone who is wearing bandages for an open wound.
- No running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, or causing undue disturbance in or about the pool area is allowed.
- Bathing suits are the only appropriate swimming attire. Street clothing, tennis clothing or cut off pants are not permitted.

PRIVATE PARTIES - CAMPS

The Pool Club may be available for private parties, Birthday Parties, camps and other events. All of the aforementioned will be located under the designated white tent at the far end of facility to have little if any impact with our Members enjoyment of the club.

Opening and Closing

The Pool Club at Swansea Country Club will open on Memorial Day weekend 2020 and run through the end of September as weather allows.

In the event of inclement weather the Club reserves the right to close earlier than posted hours and notification will be posted on our Facebook page.
